

GRADE FOUR

All previous terms from Grades 1, 2, & 3 Plus:-

EN DEDANS	Inwardly
FRAPPE	To Strike
SUR LE COU-DE-PIED	On the Ankle (On the neck of the foot)
RELEVE	To snatch on the demi-pointe. The toes take place of the heel
RELEVE PASSE DERRIERE	Raising the front foot under the knee and closing the foot at the back
DEVELOPPE'	To unfold
PORT DE BRAS	Carriage of the arms
ENLAIR	In the air
CHASSE' PASSE'	A sliding movement with the back foot passing to the front (passe' en avant) or the front passing to the back (passe en arriere) End in a demi-plie in 4th
DEMI-POINTE	Half pointe
PASSE	Passing
PAS DE BOURREE	A compound step consisting of three small steps, the first two on the demi-pointe and the third on the flat, with demi-plie

PAS DE BASQUE

A movement derived from the swaying of the skirt

BALANCE

A graceful transferring of the weight from foot to foot
