

UNIFORM FOR DANCE CLASSES AT TREVONNE

To ensure the safe practise of dance it is important for all students to wear set uniform during classes. There is a set uniform for all levels and genre of dance.

There are many benefits to having a uniform, but we do not ask students to have uniform until they're settled into their lessons with us. Every student is expected to purchase the correct uniform eventually.

All uniform can be purchased from the dance school .

Jewelry is not to be worn for any lessons including earrings & nose rings. If they cannot be removed, they must be covered with tape.

- **Hair** – BALLET, TAP, MODERN hair tied up neatly in a **bun**.
ACROBATICS, MUSICAL THEATRE, COMMERCIAL, STREET, CONTEMPORARY hair to be tied up neatly.
- **Boys – Ballet, Modern, Tap, Acro & Dinky Dance**
 - White boys' leotard / Black boys leotard
 - Black shorts
 - Jazz shoes, Tap shoes or ballet shoes
- **Girls - Ballet**
 - Black uniform leotard: Juvenile – grade 3 (Freed)
: Grade 3-Advanced (Capezio)
 - Pink ballet socks or ballet tights & ballet shoes
 - Black ballet skirts for younger grades
- **Girls - Tap**
 - Black uniform leotard: Juvenile – grade 3 (Freed)
: Grade 3-Advanced (Capezio)
 - Black Lycra tights from grade 2 upwards
 - Black tap shoes

- **Girls - Modern**
 - Black uniform leotard: Juvenile – grade 3 (Freed)
: Grade 3-Advanced (Capezio)
 - Black cropped Lycra tights from Primary upwards
 - Tan Jazz shoes

- **Girls - Acrobatics**
 - Black uniform leotard: Juvenile – grade 3 (Freed)
: Grade 3-Advanced (Capezio)
 - Black cropped Lycra tights from Prep upwards

- **Dinky Dance**
 - Pink Lycra leotard & Skirt. Ballet shoes & Tap shoes

- **Musical Theatre**
 - Black bright Sparks T-Shirt, Black trousers
 - Tan jazz shoe

- **Commercial, Street, Contemporary & Stretch & Flex**
 - Own choice of Black fitted clothing
 - Socks & INDOOR trainers optional
